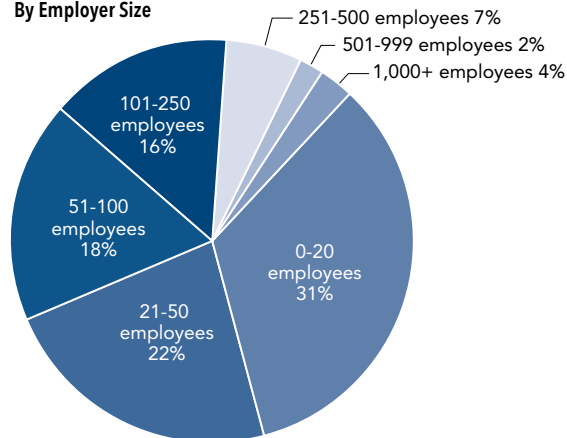


The California Chamber of Commerce is the largest broad-based business advocate to government in California.

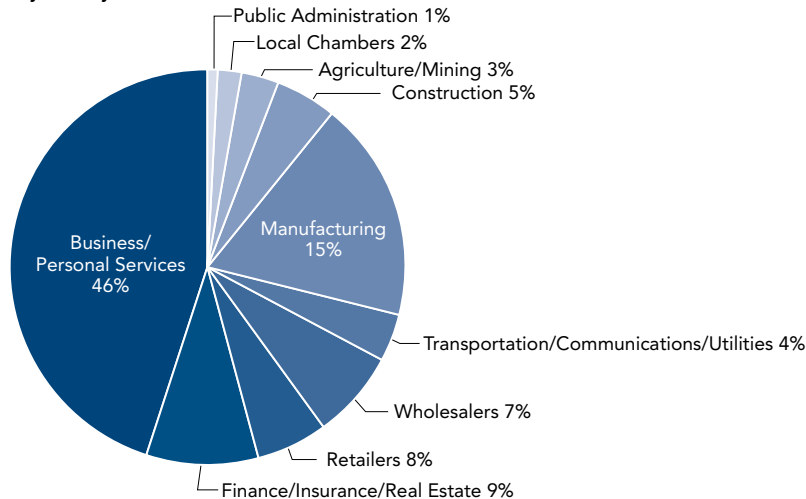

More Than Two-Thirds of CalChamber Members Have 100 or Fewer Employees

Based on a survey of members in January 2017:

- 28% have been in existence for 50 years or more; 8% for 100 years or more.
- 10% have been in existence for less than 10 years.
- 17% are owned/co-owned by women.
- 23% are owned/co-owned by ethnic minorities or persons of mixed ethnicity.
- 34% do business internationally.
- 44% plan to add employees in 2017, while 54% plan to maintain the size of their workforce.
- 91% offer health insurance coverage and 82% offer a retirement savings plan.
