What is ChamberPAC?

ChamberPAC is a bipartisan political action committee (PAC) that makes direct contributions to state and local candidates and elected officials who promote and vote for an agenda of private sector job creation. ChamberPAC provides a unique opportunity for the entire business community to pool its resources to have a greater impact on legislative campaigns through organized political action.

How ChamberPAC Works

ChamberPAC was developed so that the business community — “job creators” — could collectively impact legislative campaigns. ChamberPAC is bipartisan and members of the CalChamber’s Board of Directors, comprised of business leaders keenly aware of the community’s concerns, provide strategic advice and oversight to PAC operations.

Contributions are made to candidates and elected officials based on their past and continuing support of the business community’s agenda. Decisions are made with the ultimate goal of creating a strong and prosperous economy for the state and a better quality of life for all Californians.

Why Contribute to ChamberPAC?

ChamberPAC supports candidates and elected officials who fight the “job killer” legislative agenda promoted by personal injury lawyers, public employee unions and tax-and-spend elected officials. Since 1997, more than 700 legislative bills have been labeled as “job killers.” CalChamber has defeated 93% of those bills working with legislators supported by ChamberPAC.
