







U.S. - Chile Trade Fact Sheet: Focus on California



- Total bilateral trade has grown 215% since 2003
- In the 5 years since the FTA became effective, Chile's Exports to the U.S. grew 121% → from \$3.5 billion in 2003 to \$ 8 billion in 2008
- Since the FTA, Chile's Imports from the U.S. rose from \$2.5 billion to \$10.8 billion → 331% increase

California-Chile Bilateral Trade 2004-2008



- Chile California total bilateral trade has grown 178% since 2004
- Chile's Exports to California (\$808 million) are than Chile's exports to Colombia or the U.K.
- Chile's Imports from California grew 626% → \$233 million in 2003 to \$1.7 billion in 2008
