McWong, a California Environmental Company, to Forge a Strategic Partnership to Tap the Huge Water-Treatment Market in China

McWong, a California environmental engineering company headquartered in Sacramento with offices in Shanghai and Beijing, is in the final stage of negotiations with **Shanghai Huayi (Group) Company** to form a strategic partnership to clean up industrial water in China.

McWong has engineered and built numerous industrial wastewater treatment facilities in China for the last 17 years deploying technologies and equipment. Exporting U.S. made equipment to China has been a major part of its business. The company received the Small Business Administration's "Exporter of the Year" Award for the Western Region in 2011, and the coveted U.S. Presidential "E" Award from the Secretary of Commerce in 2012.

Huayi is a chemical conglomerate headquartered in Shanghai with 40,000 employees and annual revenue of US\$6.5 billion.
